It's once again time to say goodbye and good luck to our Prekindergarten students as they begin their journey to kindergarten. Our 2017/2018 Graduation commencement will be held on Saturday, May 19<sup>th</sup> at The Heron Bay Marriott Hotel. The schedule for the ceremonies is as follows:

The Fireflies ceremony begins at 10:00am. The Dragonflies ceremony begins 11:30am. The Beatlebugs ceremony begins at 1:00pm. Caps and gowns will need to be ironed and brought on a hanger, not in a bag, to the ceremony.

### **Tuition Payments**

Payments are due at the first of each month. It is past due on the 3<sup>rd</sup> and late fee of \$15.00 will apply. All weekly payments must have a credit card authorization on file

and tuition will be charged on Monday mornings.

No exceptions. Please make sure that your credit card and payment information is up to date and correct. If you make any future changes, please notify the front office. All declined credit cards will be charged a \$10.00 fee. The minimum amount to charge is \$10.00. All declined checks will have a \$35.00 service charge. Please sign up for automatic tuition deductions. No tuition balances will be allowed.

#### Pro-care Check in and out

It is required by Child Care Licensing that every child is signed in and out every day they are in attendance at Kids Academy. Please make sure everyone on your pick up list knows the importance of signing your child in or out.

Our Pro-care sign in-out system uses a fingerprint or code sign-in and out. Please register your fingerprint if you have not already done so.

We are enrolling for our Kids Academy Summer Camp! We have many exciting activities planned for summer camp.

Campers must have Kids Academy camp shirts. Camp shirts will be on sale for \$12.00. The children must wear these shirts every day.

Summer Sessions are in 2 week sessions. We have many fun field trips planned for our campers as well as incorporating exciting events on campus.

- Sports Fun-The first 2 weeks of camp our soccer coaches will be coming daily every morning to teach the children soccer skills and team building.
- Art- The campers will be using the art studio to learn about different artists and to create their own masterpieces.
   At the end of the 2 week session each child will take home a personal art portfolio.
- Engineering and Building The children will be building individual wind turbines and learning about other possible energy sources. We will also be exploring STEM activities to encourage problems solving and teamwork skills.
- Cooking- The campers will be participating in different cooking activities. This will allow the children to practice their math and reading skills while creating delicious dishes.

Art Classes are going well. The children have been working with clay and items they have found in nature. Ms. Ruth, our art teacher, has taken the children outside to explore and collect items found in nature and brought them into the art studio. The children have used the items that they have found and worked them into their clay projects.
